Closing the Outcomes for nine KnowledgeWorks early college high schools in Ohio.

Outside research from the American Institutes for Research (AIR) on Ohio KnowledgeWorks early college high schools shows that students at KnowledgeWorks schools significantly outperformed a group similar students at a non-KnowledgeWorks schools on the OGT (by between 2 and 7 points [note that this is across subjects], on average), and the odds of students at KnowledgeWorks schools graduating from high school were about 1.6 times greater than the those for matched comparisons.




