

SBAC Results Comparison



Celebrations

- ✓ LUSD performed 4% above the county average in SBAC ELA.
- ✓ LUSD grew 7% in SBAC ELA and 5% in SBAC Math. This exceeded county and state growth.
- Compared to 63 similar districts, LUSD ranked first in SBAC ELA growth in 2019.
- LUSD improved from the 33th to the 87th percentile rank in SBAC ELA achievement in the past 3 years when comparing similar school districts in California.
- ✓ LUSD improved from the 15th percentile to the 51st percentile in SBAC ELA and from the 14th to the 38th percentile in SBAC Math in the last 3 years when comparing all Unified School Districts in California.
